

# Fairy-go-Round DOMINO GAME



## Instructions

Includes: 36 dominoes  
2-4 players

### Basic Game

Ages 3+

**Object:** To be the first to play all of your dominoes by matching colored fairies.

**Set Up:** Turn dominoes flower side up and fairy side down and scramble them. Each player takes 9 dominoes and turns them fairy side up. In a 2- or 3-person game, there will be some dominoes left over. Put those aside. They will not be needed. Place the flower petal game board in the center of the table so all players can reach it. The youngest player goes first and play continues clockwise.

**How to Play:** To start, player 1 plays a fairy domino of the same color as one edge of the flower petal game board. For example, player 1 might place a pink fairy domino at the pink edge. The next player could play another edge domino or could match a fairy to the fairy on the other side of the first played domino. Each player plays 1 domino per turn. If a player cannot play a domino in the game or on a start petal, the player misses a turn.

**Rainbow Wands:** A rainbow wand can be played on any fairy, and players may match any fairy to a rainbow wand. Rainbow wands cannot be played as a first edge piece. If a player plays a rainbow wand, that player goes again.

**Game End:** The first player to play all dominoes wins! To increase the length of play in a 2- or 3-person game, divide up all 36 dominoes among the players rather than dealing 9 to each. Game play is the same as the basic game.

## Challenge Game

Ages 5+

**Set Up:** Turn dominoes flower side up and fairy side down and scramble them. Each player takes 3 dominoes and holds them in her hand. Place the remaining dominoes in a draw pile where everyone can reach them. Place the flower petal game board in the center of the table. The youngest player goes first and play continues clockwise.

**How to Play:** Each player plays 1 domino per turn and then picks another domino from the draw pile. As in the basic game, the first player plays a domino on the flower edge and play continues either by playing a domino on a start edge or matching a fairy to a domino. If a player cannot play a domino she misses a turn.

**Rainbow Wands:** A rainbow wand can be played on any fairy. Rainbow wands cannot be played as a first edge piece. If a player plays a rainbow wand, that player goes again, however, that rainbow wand domino ends that fairy line. No more dominoes may be played on that rainbow wand domino. After player goes again, player picks up 1 domino only from the draw pile. Players will have only 2 dominoes in their hands after playing a wand.

**Game End:** The first player to play all dominoes wins! If no player can play a domino, all players should put all dominoes from their hand back into the draw pile. Scramble those dominoes and have each player take the same number of dominoes she put back into the draw pile. Resume play. If the draw pile is gone and players still hold dominoes in their hands, the game is a tie.

## Super Challenge Game

Ages 5+

For an even more challenging game, flip the dominoes over and play flower side up. In this version, players can play any domino to start. Play as if playing the basic game but matching dots instead of fairies.
